Dredge Report:

Discussed moving dredge with volunteers and there were no issues with this. Pen has been allocated on the southern side of the marina traditionally nicknamed Mangrove pen. Volunteers raised point that boats are getting stuck on the spoil on the southern side of the marina. Possibility to dredge this section before any thoughts of decommissioning dredge or maintenance works are done. Discussion held on possible soil relocation areas.
